Mobility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist with the use of adaptive equipment such as cane, walker or w/c. Assist with transfers including use of adaptive equipment such as gait belt, w/c, grab-bar, tub seat Assist with positioning in a bed, w/c or other furniture 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lift more than 25 pounds of weight Assist with position if the client has an open wound or bed sore that could be affected by repositioning

Hair Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist with shampooing, drying, combing or styling hair 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist with shampoo that is medicated or requires a prescription
Nail Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist with nail care including soaking nails, pushing back cuticles with using utensils Clip/cut finger or toenails of non-diabetics Filing and polishing nails 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clip or cut toenails for diabetic clients
Shaving	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist with shaving using an electric razor or safety razor 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist with shaving using a straight edge razor
Makeup	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist with makeup, except mascara 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Apply mascara

Hearing Aids	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist with putting in or taking out • Turn on/off by opening the battery door • Assist with adjusting the volume • Change the battery 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean the inside of a hearing aid
Medication	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medication reminders • Prompt to take meds • Open and hand medication must be pre-dosed in a medication reminder or blister pack • Open non-prescription medication (i.e. Tylenol) bottles • Assist with medicated patches by providing verbal reminders or opening a package 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Distribute medication that has not been predosed • Distribute medication directly from a prescription bottle that is not predosed • Dose medication from a non-prescription bottle (i.e. Tylenol) • Crush or alter form of medication • Place medication into a client's mouth or distribute medication in any form • Apply or remove a medicated patch
Respiratory Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temporarily remove and replace a cannula or mask from clients face for eating, hygiene or oral care • Assist with a nebulizer treatment by opening a predosed vial of medication and pouring it into a nebulizer cup according to a pre-defined schedule • Assist with a nebulizer treatment by turning it on/off and cleaning the tube according to manufacturer's instructions 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adjust oxygen flow or levels or regulate pressure • Turn off or change oxygen tanks • Transfer between a portable and a stationary oxygen tank • Measure medication into a nebulizer cup that is not predosed
Feeding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist with feeding clients who can be positioned upright and independently swallow 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Perform feeding if the client is high risk for choking
Skin Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply non-prescription lotion, powders or ointments • Assist with a small cut or abrasion by washing with soap and water and applying bandage • Change bandage on a small cut or abrasion 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply prescription lotions, powders or ointments • Change dressing to an open wound
