Re: Campus updates

Testing update:

As of Wednesday, October 14th seven staff members on the Evergreen campus are positive for COVID-19. Four people are currently under quarantine at home and three people have recovered and have been cleared to return to work by Evergreen's Infection Control Preventionist and Employee Health Nurse. We continue to follow guidance issued by public health and the CDC to safely manage the situation. Individuals who have come into contact with a person who tested positive have been notified.

Staff will continue to complete symptom screening before each shift and we are following state guidance for on-going testing. Staff impacted by COVID-19 are following quarantine guidelines. Ongoing resident testing in the Health Center will continue per state guidance and testing in Assisted Living and other areas of campus will continue as symptoms occur. At this time there are no known cases of COVID-19 among our residents.

All visitation in the Health Center remains suspended until further notice.

The spread of COVID-19 remains uncontrolled and numbers in Winnebago County continue to climb. Our residents and staff remain our first priority and we're grateful for your diligence, support and understanding as we continue to navigate the ever changing conditions.

November election:

Completed absentee ballots may be dropped off at Resident & Guest Services in the secure ballot box.

Self-Screen Kiosks:

Self-screening Kiosks are being installed at door 1 and 2. The system is not yet operational so please continue to have guests sign in the log books as they have been until instructions have been communicated via memo and signage. We anticipate we will start using the kiosks in early November.
