

Dear Families,

Evergreen has established a visitation policy for the Health Center that will follow data for Winnebago County. The following information will help you anticipate the visitation process going forward and when visits may resume.

- RED – positivity rate of 10% or higher – Compassionate Care visits only.
- YELLOW – positivity rate between 5.7% and 9.9% – Indoor visits may resume. Visitors will be asked to arrive 20 minutes prior to their visit to be tested for COVID-19. Those with positive results will not be able to visit. Approved visitors are required to wear a mask and will be escorted to the family member’s room for a 30 minute visit. Folding chairs and a plexiglass divider will be set up to ensure a safe, no-contact visit.
- GREEN – positivity rate of 5.7% or lower - Approved visitors are required to wear a mask and will be escorted to the family member’s room for a 30 minute visit. Folding chairs and a plexiglass divider will be set up to ensure a safe, no-contact visit.

All visitations will be suspended if an Evergreen resident or essential care staff in the Health Center has received a COVID-19 positive test even if the county numbers indicate opportunity for visitation. Visitation will then be restricted until there have been no new COVID-19 cases for 14 days and/or based on guidance from Winnebago Public Health..

This policy is subject to change as we continue to navigate the ever changing conditions. We are grateful for your support and understanding; any changes will be communicated with families as soon as possible.
