Dear Families,

Last week there were three staff members on the Evergreen campus that tested positive for COVID-19. In total, seven staff are off and quarantined with COVID. We continue to follow guidance issued by public health and the CDC to safely manage the situation which includes testing two times each week. Individuals who have come into contact with a person who tested positive have been notified.

Ongoing resident testing will continue every three-seven days or as symptoms arise per state guidelines. Last week there was one new positive case of COVID-19 among our residents in the Health Center. The resident had been in isolation and extra precautions are in place.

At this time, visitation remains suspended until further notice due to the high positivity rate in Winnebago County. We will re-assess the situation weekly and resume regular activities and visitation as soon as possible.
