This week two staff and one resident on the Evergreen campus tested positive for COVID-19. Visitation in the Creekview Health Center remains suspended until further notice. Ongoing testing will continue per state guidelines. Please share this important visitation information with friends and family who may plan to visit Evergreen.

Our changes in protocols throughout the COVID-19 pandemic have been to make sure we're doing as much as we can to help protect the health and safety of everyone on our campus. That's why we've decided to require all staff to become fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Those that are still unvaccinated will be given until Monday, November 1, 2021 to get the first dose of vaccine as a condition of employment similar to the flu vaccine. Staff will be required to be fully vaccinated by December 15, 2021.

Our residents and staff remain our first priority and we're grateful for your support and understanding as we continue to navigate the ever changing conditions.
