Please stop in and say hello, email, or give me a call. I'd love to share the exciting things we have planned for this new year or answer any questions you may have.

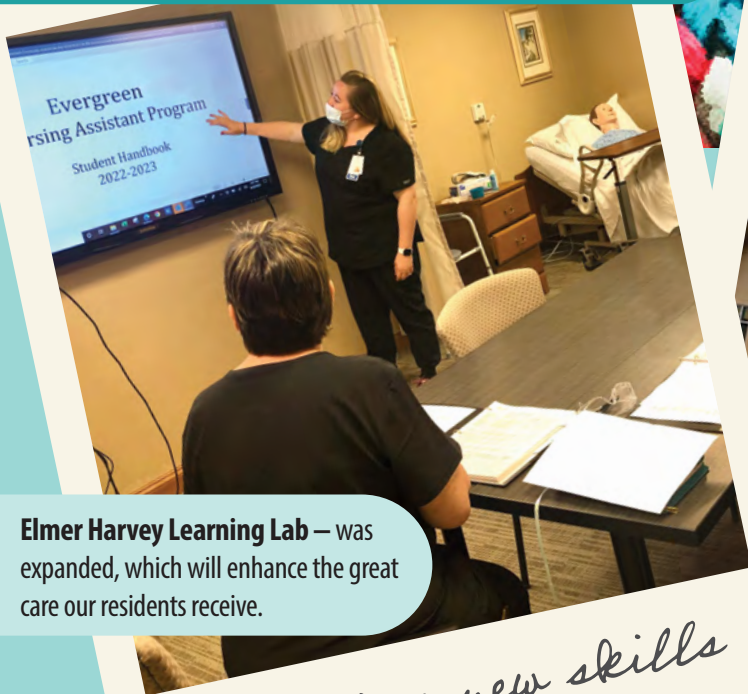

Manor View, part of Evergreen's Assisted Living, recently was updated! The updates include a smart board, t-coil hearing loop, armchairs and room darkening shades for a cinema space, along with microphones and speaker, activity tables, stackable chairs, and a new storage cabinet for the activity area. All were made possible through donations to the Evergreen Foundation!

Because of these updates, Manor View has begun holding Cardio Drumming classes, which are a huge hit! By using a pair

of drumsticks, a fitness ball, and a chair, in which the fitness ball sits, residents are able to exercise while drumming to their favorite music. Cardio Drumming promotes cardiovascular health, can reduce stress and anxiety, increases strength, and improves coordination, motor skills and hand-eye coordination. It is a low-impact workout that people of all ages and fitness levels can do ~ and it's fun.

GIVING can be directed in the following ways:

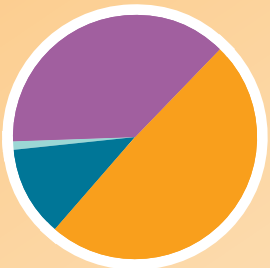

TOTAL DONATIONS: \$422,423

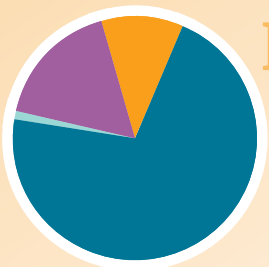

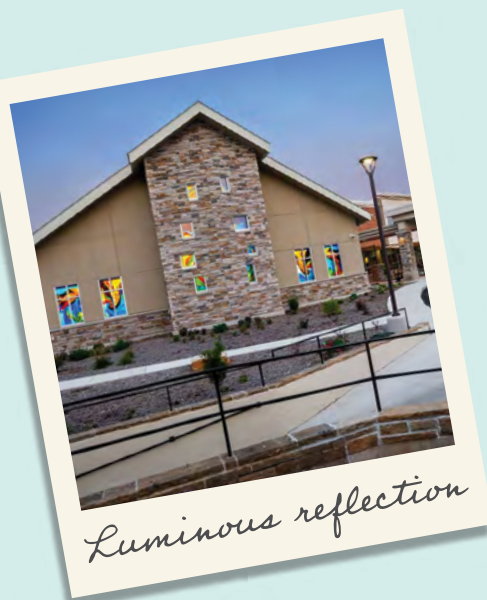
