2024: Key Accomplishments

In 2024, the Foundation achieved significant milestones, including:

Expansion of the Elmer Harvey Learning Lab:

One of our most notable accomplishments was supporting the expansion of the Elmer Harvey Learning Lab, which trains Certified Nursing Assistants (CNAs). This expansion allowed us to increase the number of individuals we can train, which helped staffing in our health center.

Partnership with University of Wisconsin Oshkosh (UWO):

The Foundation also played an important role in transitioning the Learning in Retirement (LIR) program to Evergreen in collaboration with UWO. Without this support, the program would have ceased to exist. As a result, residents and community members will continue to benefit from lifelong learning opportunities, and we hope to expand these programs in the future.

As we move into 2025, we anticipate a growing need for housing and services, especially as baby boomers begin to turn 80. Evergreen's event bus connects residents to concerts, local events, and dining out.

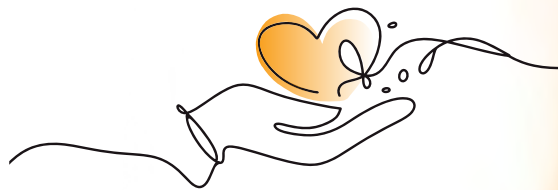

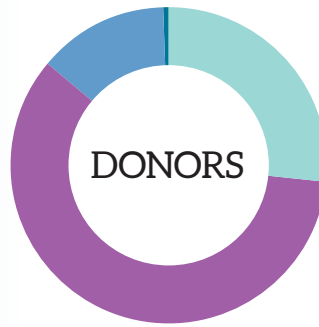
Other ways to GIVE:

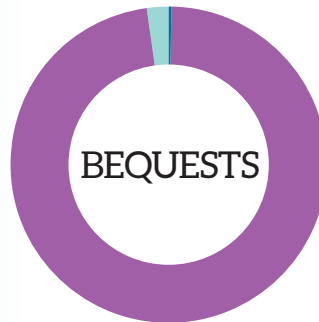

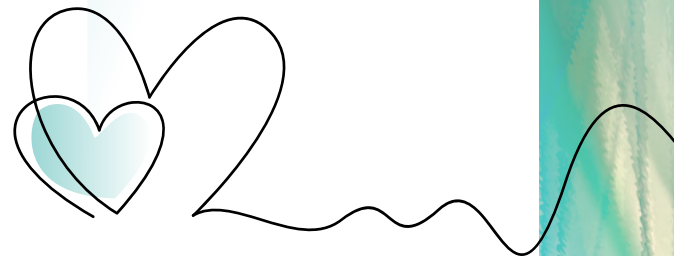

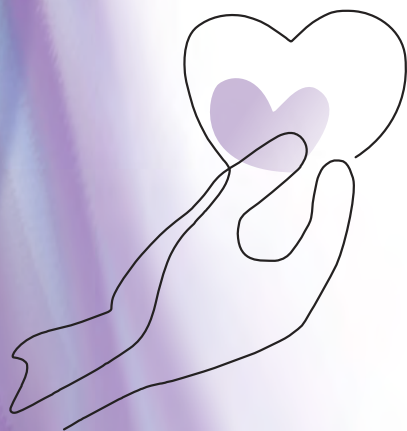
